# **DETAILED ITINERARY**

#### **ADDIS ABABA**

Day 1 - Arrive in Addis Ababa. Transfer to Saro-Maria Hotel, an attractive four star hotel in the center of Addis.

#### **ADDIS ABABA**

Day 2- Today we will have full day sightseeing tour of the capital which includes the Ethnological Museum in the former palace of King Hailesillassie, the National (Archaeological) Museum, the superb Holy Trinity Cathedral, the various historical monuments of Addis Ababa; and Merkato largest open-air market in Africa. We will visit Mount Entoto for panoramic view point at the highest pick in Addis with an altitude of 3200 meters and St. Mary Church, Beza Entoto Workshop, St George Cathedral and Museum, Baheta Mariam church.

#### **WOLISO-ADDIS ABABA**

Day 5 - In the morning drive 32 km southwest of Bahir Dar to the small town of Tiss Abay to visit the Blue Nile Falls. We will walk some distances to the Falls and visit some of the villages around

there.

**LAKE TANA** 

Day 6 - In the morning we will have a boat excursion in Ethiopia's largest water body, Lake Tana (3,600 sq km) to visit the monasteries of Ura Kidane Mihret and Azwa Mariam which are found on the largest peninsula of the lake.

These monasteries are known for the colorful frescoes of religious scenes, different ancient types of crosses, paintings, murals and an impressive display of illuminated Bibles written in Ge'ez, Ethiopia's oldest language

**GONDAR** 

Day 7- Early Morning drive to Gondar - Gondar was the first capital city of the Ethiopian empire,

which began in 1632 with the reign of King Fasilledes. In Gondar there are dozens of castles built

by various emperors over the course of 236 years.

Gondar visit includes the palaces, residences and open air baths of King Fasilledes; (World

Heritage Site by UNESCO), the monasteries of Qusquom, the church of Debre Berhan Sellassie

(Light of the Trinity) with its 16th century paintings and frescoes, which is located at the summit

of a hill and surrounded by fortified walls.

**SEMIEN MOUNTAIN** 

Day 8 - In the morning we will visit Beta Israel or the Felasha Mura in the outskirts of Gondar.

Continue drive to the Semien Mountains National Park via Debark the gateway to the park and

continue driving to reach to Sankaber 3230masl through a beautiful scenery and Ahmara people

and villages. The Semien Mountains National Park is a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and we

will visit its exceptional natural beauty which includes superb scenery, endemic fauna and flora.

Among other endemics it is here that the Gelada Baboon (bleeding heart Baboon) is found.

pink granite rock; they have been classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Each church (Bet)

has a unique architectural style; all are superbly carved and most of them are decorated with

well-preserved paintings. We will visit the first group of Rock hewn Churches.

obelisks; the largest single pieces of stone standing anywhere on the world (World Heritage

Site by UNESCO), castles of former monarchs, the Axum Museum and Mariam tsion Church,

built on the site of Ethiopia's first church AD, and palace of Sheba and the Gundit stelae field,

King Ezana's inscriptions and the tombs of Kings Kaleb and Gebre Meskel.

Day 15 - drive to Hamdela and at Berhale pay entrance and have permission from Berhale

Administration bureau and also take two police men and road guide and continue drive to

Hamedela along unmarked sandy tracks, passing Afar settlements along the way. Ahmedela is the

base for exploring the salt mines and seeing the salt workers and camel caravans.

**ERTA ALE** 

Day 16- Drive to Kusrewat here where we arrange the camel to trek to the volcano and to ascend

our logistics and for those who wish to ride, Local militia and rock guide apart from those who

already with us. Late afternoon start walking to Erta Ale. After a 3 hours trek, climb to Erta Ale

volcano and over-night on the top of the mountain. Erta Ale is 613 meters tall, with a lava lake at the

summit.

Day 17 - Drive to Dallol, Visit the hot springs at Dallol, composed of different minerals along with

sulphurs and potash and create spectacular colors. Dallol is renowned as being the hottest

inhabited place on earth; You are likely to see the long 'caravane de sel' - camel trains loaded

with salt and visit Lake Asale Salt mining with the Salt workers & see the merchants from the

highland Salt Market.

Day 18 - Drive to Mekele through the town of Berhale. Ascend to the Tigrian highland with

**AWASSA** 

Day 19 - In the morning fly to Addis Ababa and meet the car to drive to Awassa en route vsit

some of Debrezeit (Bishoftu) crater Lakes such as Hora, Babogaya, and Kuriftu. Continue driving

throught the great Rift valley lakes, Langano and Abijatta-Shalla and the town of Awassa, the

capital city of the southern region, which is very popular in fish market and its volcanic lake. The

rift contains a marvelous series of lakes, which are teeming with fish and provide a habitat for

hundreds of species of birds. On the way we pass 4 of the lakes. Awassa is located on the edge

of Lake Awassa, surrounded by mountains.

**ARBAMINCH** 

Day 20 - We drive through one of the most colorful and scenic areas of Southern Ethiopia, a

land that is inhabited by the people of the Sidamo, the Alaba, who were once nomads but are

now farmers. A long section of the road offers magnificent views of Lake Abaya, surrounded by

mountains. The lake has volcanic origins and is almost pink in color. Today we visit the Dorze

village, one of the many small group of tribes in southern Ethiopia. Once warriors, the Dorze are

now turned to farming and weaving to earn a living.

KONSO-KEYAFER MARKET

Day 21 - Drive to Turmi en route meet the people of Konso and their villages. The cornerstone of Konso culture is a highly specialized and successful agricultural economy. Meet the people, take photographs and learn of a culture that has had very little outside influence and continue

to Turmi. We will visit the weekly market of the Hamer and Bena in KeyAfer Market (Thursday

Market) a highlight of Omo Valley where all the ethnic tribes come to shop. The market is

exciting and you may have the opportunity to buy some of the tribal regalia and artifacts.

**TURMI-OMORATE** 

Day 22- In the morning we drive to Omo Rate crossing the Omo River by boat to visit the Galab village in the bank of the lower Omo valley. One of a small group of the Omo Valley tribes, called Dasanach. This day we drive towards the Dus/Kangate area to see the Karo ethnic group in Korcho villages, experts in body painting, using clays and locally available vegetable pigments to

trace fantastic patterns on each other's faces, chests, arms and legs.

Included Activities: Tribal area, Villages, Dasanach tribes in Omo Rate, Karo-Tribes

Travel Distance 160 km

DIMEKA MARKET-TURMI

Day 23 - Drive to Jinka and en route visit one of the colorful markets of the Omo valley in

Keyafer. It is Saturday and there is a Market where all the tribes gather to socialize and also for

the market In Dimeka . Continue driving to Jinka to visit the Ari village.

Included Activities: visit the Mursis Village, meet with the people and Market

MAGO

Day 24 - Morning drive to Mago National Park located in the eastern bank of the Omo River.

From here we will visit the Mursi highlands where the most illustrious of Ethiopia's unique tribes

lives. The Mursis are known for their decorative lip plates that adorn the lower lips of the Mursi

women. The various cultural aspects of the tribe will be explained and you will be able to take

their photographs and interact with them.

## Terms of payment

Program contracts and service agreements become valid upon Amazing Ethiopia Tours' confirmation of the booking by e-mail. A deposit of 20% of the total cost is requested at the time of confirmation. The remainder of the total cost is payable 30 days before the beginning date of the tour.

Credit Card Acceptance: Limited.

**Travellers Cheques:** Very difficult to exchange and are not recommended.

#### Climate

Ethiopia is generally pleasant and warm, but varies with altitude. The long rains usually arrive mid- June to early September and the short rains between mid-February and April.

The temperature all year round rarely falls below 18°C . Average temperature in day time is around 21-23 Degree Celsius.

Footwear

Comfortable, good walking shoes with ankle support are strongly recommended as well as comfortable sandals.

One main piece of baggage and a daypack. Please note that there is a weight restriction of 7kg for hand luggage/daypack for international and internal flights.

Clothing

Daytime temperatures are mainly warm and comfortable but evenings in the highlands can be cold. We recommend a thick jumper or warm fleece and lightweight wind/waterproof clothing. Take a sun hat. The sun is very strong in high altitudes so sunscreen, sunglasses and a cap are important.

Equipment

Bring sun cream, a torch and memory cards for your camera. An insect repellent against fleas could be useful for some places in the North.

Visa Requirements

visa is required for all visitors to Ethiopia and they can get from Ethiopian Diplomatic Mission abroad ,Visitors from the countries listed below can obtain visa on arrival at Bole International Airport (Addis Ababa): Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea Republic, Kuwait, Luxemburg, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Russian Federation, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, UK, and US.

**Health Requirements** 

Malaria precautions should be taken before visiting the lowlands. However, vaccination is not obligatory and not necessarily taken as a major preparation while you arrange your travel document. Visa and vaccination requirements are subject to change and should be confirmed before departure.
